Still, pancreatic cancer is the fourth leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States, yet receives the least amount of federal research funding of all major cancer killers—and is decades behind other cancers in research discoveries and treatment options.

GET INVOLVED WITH YOUR LOCAL AFFILIATE

The Pancreatic Cancer Action Network has active affiliates in more than 75 cities across the United States. Our affiliates are made up of dedicated and passionate volunteers who are the driving force behind the progress we have made as an organization. Affiliate volunteers work as a team to raise much-needed awareness and funds and educate their communities about pancreatic cancer.

TALK TO HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

Volunteers distribute Patient and Liaison Services (PALS) program information to local healthcare professionals so that each diagnosis is accompanied by a referral to call a highly trained PALS Associate. We provide comprehensive information and resources about the disease, treatment options, clinical trials, diet and nutrition, etc., throughout the course of treatment—free of charge.

CONTACT THE MEDIA

Pancreatic cancer is the least understood and least known of all the major cancer killers. In order to raise awareness, it is vital to engage the media. One article, one news story, one announcement can send our message to an entire community, so we encourage you to share your story with the press. We provide you with all of the necessary tools and templates for your media outreach efforts.

ADVOCATE FOR MORE RESEARCH FUNDING

The federal government is the largest source of funding for biomedical research in the United States, and is capable of moving research forward faster than any private organization.
